

# Terms & Conditions – Over My Dead Body Murder Mystery Events

By booking, hosting, or participating in an Over My Dead Body (OMDB) Murder Mystery event, you acknowledge and agree to the following Terms & Conditions.

## 1. Participation at Own Risk

Participation in OMDB events is voluntary and at the participant's own risk. While every reasonable effort is made to ensure the safety, comfort, and enjoyment of all attendees, OMDB and its facilitators accept no liability for injury, illness, allergic reactions, or other adverse effects that may occur during or after the event, except where required by law.

## 2. Nature of the Event

OMDB events are immersive, interactive entertainment experiences which may include role-play, themed props, light movement, and audience participation. All elements are intended purely for entertainment purposes. Participants must follow the instructions of the host or facilitator at all times and use props or materials only as directed.

## 3. Personal Property and Clothing

OMDB is not responsible for any loss, damage, or staining to clothing, accessories, personal belongings, or property that may occur during participation in the event. Participants are advised to wear suitable clothing for an interactive event environment.

## 4. Behaviour and Conduct

Participants are expected to behave respectfully toward facilitators, venue staff, and other guests. OMDB reserves the right to remove or refuse participation to any individual whose behaviour is disruptive, unsafe, abusive, or inappropriate. In such cases, no refund or compensation will be provided.

## 5. Responsibility for Minors

OMDB events are primarily designed for adults. Where minors are present, they must be supervised at all times by a parent or legal guardian. OMDB facilitators are not responsible for supervising children or minors.

## 6. Venue Responsibilities

Where the client is responsible for arranging the venue, the client must ensure the venue is suitable, safe, and appropriate for the event, including providing adequate indoor shelter where required. If adverse weather conditions, venue safety issues, or circumstances beyond OMDB's control prevent the safe continuation of the event, OMDB reserves the right to modify or terminate the event at the facilitator's discretion. Refunds or rescheduling in such cases will be considered only where agreed in writing.

## 7. Damage to Props and Equipment

The booking client agrees to be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to props, costumes, or equipment caused by attendees, guests, or pets during the event. The client may be charged for repair or replacement where damage occurs.

## 8. Health, Allergies, and Sensitivities

Participants are responsible for informing the host or facilitator of any allergies, sensitivities, or medical conditions that could reasonably affect their participation. Participants should not consume, apply, or otherwise use any materials or props unless explicitly indicated as safe for such use.

## 9. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, OMDB and its facilitators shall not be liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential losses arising from participation in the event. Nothing in these Terms excludes liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence where such exclusion would be unlawful.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and protect your information when you interact with our website, make a booking, or participate in our events. This policy complies with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and applicable Irish data protection law.

## 1. Who We Are

Over My Dead Body (OMDB) provides interactive murder mystery events for private parties, corporate groups, and special occasions.

## 2. What Personal Data We Collect

We may collect and process the following types of personal data:

### Information you provide to us

When you book an event, make an enquiry, or contact us, we may collect:

- Name
- Email address
- Phone number
- Billing information
- Event details (date, location, group size)
- Any information you choose to provide in messages or booking forms

### Event participation information

For event planning purposes we may collect:

- Guest names (optional)
- Character selections for role-play events
- Accessibility or dietary information if voluntarily provided

### Website information

When you visit our website we may collect:

- IP address
- Browser type and device information
- Website usage data via cookies or analytics tools

### 3. How We Use Your Information

We use your personal data to:

- Process bookings and payments;
- Communicate about your event;
- Provide and manage our services;
- Respond to enquiries;
- Improve our website and services;
- Send relevant information about bookings or event logistics.

If you subscribe to a mailing list, we may also send occasional updates or offers. You can unsubscribe at any time.

### 4. Legal Basis for Processing

Under GDPR, we process personal data based on one or more of the following lawful bases:

Contractual necessity - To manage bookings and provide event services.

Legitimate interests - To operate and improve our business and services.

Consent - Where you opt in to marketing communications or newsletters.

Legal obligations - Where required for accounting, tax, or regulatory purposes.

### 5. Sharing Your Information

We do not sell or rent personal data.

We may share information only where necessary with trusted service providers, such as:

- Payment processors;
- Booking or scheduling platforms;
- Website hosting or analytics providers;
- Event collaborators where required for delivery of the event.

These providers process data only as necessary to perform their services.

### 6. Data Storage and Security

We take reasonable technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against loss, misuse, or unauthorised access.

Your information is stored securely and only retained for as long as necessary for:

- Providing services;
- Legal or accounting obligations;
- Legitimate business purposes.

### 7. Your Rights Under GDPR

You have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- Right to access your data;
- Right to correct inaccurate information;
- Right to request deletion of your data;
- Right to restrict processing;
- Right to data portability;
- Right to withdraw consent for marketing;
- Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

In Ireland, this authority is the Data Protection Commission (DPC).

## **8. Cookies**

Our website may use cookies or similar technologies to improve user experience and analyse website traffic. You can manage cookie preferences through your browser settings.

## **9. Third-Party Links**

Our website may contain links to third-party websites. OMDB is not responsible for the privacy practices of these external sites.
